

RIMROSE VALLEY ART TRAIL

From 14th July – 28th October, Liverpool is hosting the Independents Biennial 2018. Involving over 200 artists from around the world. As part of the festival, Rimrose Valley Country Park is hosting an Environmental Land Art Trail, featuring artists who are passionate about the environment, working only in natural and recycled materials. From static art and sculptures to informative trails through the valley.





Rimrose Valley is a 3.5km long country park and valley in North Liverpool which provides a vital mosaic of habitats for wildlife right at the heart of a busy, built-up urban area. Often referred to as the 'green lung' of north Liverpool by the local community, the park has been earmarked by Highways England to build a four lane motorway right through its core, destroying this vital green space and wildlife haven. All simply to facilitate easier access to the nearby Port of Liverpool for HGVs.
